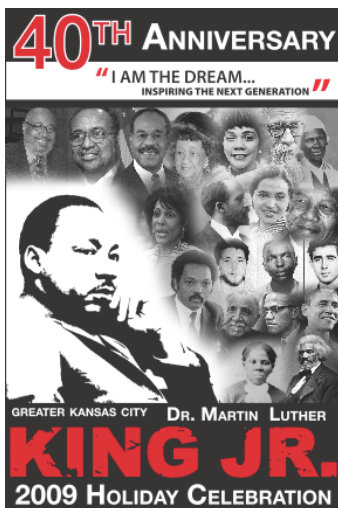


Southern Christian Leadership Conference
